

Marine and Environmental Studies Scholarship

Amount: \$5,000 Awarded Annually

Brief description:

Awarded annually to a full-time student enrolled in the first, second, third or fourth year of a recognized program related to environment, sustainable development, marine engineering, ocean mapping, natural science or related programs. The candidate must demonstrate a commitment to a career in one of these fields. Furthermore, the candidate must have an affinity towards environmental conservation.

Eligibility:

Open to Nunavut Inuit enrolled under the Nunavut Agreement. Priority will be given in the following order:

- 1. Inuit applicants from Sanirajak, Igloolik, Clyde River, Pond Inlet, Arctic Bay
- 2. Inuit from the Qikiqtani region
- 3. Inuit from the rest of Nunavut

Application instructions:

We encourage all those interested in pursuing post-secondary education to apply for one of the scholarships, even if their area of study does not completely align with the description outlined above.
